

About Program: B.Sc. Hons. Agriculture Final Year student are engaged under Rural Agricultural Work experience during Village attachment to experience farming work and challenges.


Objective

They provided us with a comprehensive introduction to the Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) Program. This program consists of seven units that we had formed during our time in the village. These units are designed to give us hands-on experience and practical knowledge in various aspects of agriculture and rural development.

- Plant Protection Intervention
- Soil Improvement Intervention
- Fruit and Vegetable production Intervention
- Food Processing Intervention
- Animal Production Intervention
- Extension and Transfer of technology

Village Survey

In our village survey we visited Borawal village and get information from farmers about family, land holding, irrigation, agronomic interventions etc. in our village survey we filled a Annexure provided for our RAWE by Punjabi University Patiala.

Agronomical Intervention

In Agronomical Intervention I had performed demonstration on mechanization in agronomical practices and comparison with local practices. In my demonstration I had given information of modern and traditional agronomical practices and difference between traditional and modern agronomical practices.

Village Attachment

DETAIL OF VILLAGE

The Borawal village is located in Mansa, Punjab. The village has geographical area of 11.55 km square. The Mansa is the district of this village with Pin code of 151502 and state code of PB. It is on Budhlada-Bhikhi road. The village has a very large pond, three gurudwaras and one C-pet camp. The tehsil of Borawal is Budhlada. It is also written as Borewal.

- Village Name: Borawal
- Village Code Number: 151502
- Geographical area: 11.54 km square
- Nearest Towns/Cities : Budhlada is the nearest city of the village Borawal, which is 9 km away from village.
- Sex Ratio: The sex ratio is the ratio of Borawal males to females. The sex ratio of Borawal is 870.

BORAWAL HOUSEHOLD AND POPULATION

The total numbers of households in Borawal village are 773. It rely on the total population of 3950 peoples. As far as male population concern the number of population is 2112 and number of female population is 1838. The reference taken to publish these data is of year 2011. The source of data is Census of India .

RURAL AGRICULTURE WORK EXPERIENCE (RAWE)

The Rural Agriculture Work Experience provides exposure to agricultural students to the natural setting of the village situations, work with farm families , identify their problems and make use of various extension tools for transferring the latest agricultural technologies. The students also get an opportunity to study the various ongoing schemes related to agriculture and rural development and



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participate in their implementation. The students would be given rigorous orientation and familiarization on various issues and problems expected on farmers' field and hence would gain competence and confidence for solving problems related to agriculture and allied sciences. It would be implemented in adopted villages under the supervision of scientists. Activities designed are mainly focused on intensive observations/analysis of socioeconomic and technological profile of the farm families in rural areas, participatory extension approach and acquaintance with farming situations, farm practices and interaction with progressive farmers. Soil testing has become the integral part of RAWE. The RAWE program.

The students will also gain the first hand information about technologies adopted by farmers and RAWE also help the students to prioritize the farmers problems, prepare village development plans and to develop skills and attitude of working with farm families for overall development in rural area. The timings for RAWE proposed coincide with the main cropping season.

Main objectives of RAWE

- To provide an opportunity to the students to understand the rural setting in relation to agriculture and allied activities.
- To make the students familiar with socio-economic conditions of the farmers and their problems.
- To impart diagnostic and remedial knowledge to the students relevant to real field situations through practical training.
- To develop communication skills in students using extension teaching methods in transfer of technology.
- To develop confidence and competence to solve agricultural problems.
- To acquaint students with on-going extension and rural development program.
- Programme of work

Plant Protection Interventions Demonstration of Preparation of Organic Input (NEEM EXTRACT)

Organic input

Organic inputs are derived from the processing of plant and animal products that the farmer brings to his crop in order for it to express its production potential. By decomposing and fermenting, organic materials from the farm or outside allow organic inputs to form. Plants inputs are, derived from plant decomposition they include compost, pruning residues, organic preparations such as extract, oilcakes etc.

Animal inputs are derived from livestock manure, such as liquid manure, guano etc. animal matter is often mixed with vegetable matter to refine the ratio between carbon and nitrogen.

The main role of organic inputs is to be used either as fertilizer for crops or as soil amendment. Fertilizers are used when the objective is to provide nutrients directly to the plant via the soil or by spraying whereas amendment is used when the objective is to improve the soil physical, chemical and biological properties.

List of organic inputs:

1. Farmyard manure
2. Green manures
3. Oil cakes
4. Leaf extract
5. Biogas slurry
6. Poultry manures.



How to use it

- This solution is actually very strong , we cannot spray it directly on the plants.
- We need to dilute this solution with water. After this, we will add 10 tablespoons of this neem liquid to 1 litre of normal water and give a nice shower to plants.

Application:

- Neem extract is a liquid solution which is used as a pesticide or insecticide to control pests as well as insects which creates damage to the plants.
- It is not directly applied on the plants. First we mix the solution with water then use as spray on plants.

Question 2. What is the price of Neem Extract in market?

Answer: Price is vary from company to company from 200 to 500 per 500ml .

Village Attachment Training Program Rural Agriculture Work Experience (RAWE) Animal Production Intervention Demonstration on Clean Milk Production

20-09-2023 to 26-09-2023

Introduction:

The dairy industry is an important segment of food industry in India as it plays a significant role in the national economy and socio-economic development of the country. It is an important source of self-employment and subsidiary occupation to the rural and semi-urban population of India. Milk provides relatively quick returns for small-scale livestock owners. It is a balanced, nutritious food and key element in household food security. Dairy industry is an integral part of livelihood of millions of people thriving on scarce resources.



Clean milk production:

Quality initiatives need to be made strong by introducing concept of clean milk production at the village level. "Clean milk" may be defined as milk drawn from the udder of healthy animals, which is collected in clean, dry milking pail and free from extraneous matter like dirt, dust, flies, hay, manure etc. clean milk has a normal milk flavor with low bacterial count and is safe for human consumption. Clean milk production is always beneficial/profitable for both the producers and the consumers because of the following reasons:

- Safe for human consumption.
- Better keeping quality and chances of spoilage minimized.
- High commercial value.
- Renders protection against disease like typhoid, dysentery, etc. which are transmitted to the milk through human contact.
- Helps to produce good quality dairy products or value-added products.

7. **Milk collection and transportation:** There should be a provision of bulk cooling tanks in order to reduce the bacteriological load in the milk immediately after collection.



Question asked by farmer:

- why should we use warm water?
To stimulate the animals for milking and also for the clean outer surface of teats.
why knuckling is not suitable for milking?
It leads to damage to the tissue of teats due to which teat become small.

Conclusion:

Diary animal should be healthy and clean especially the hindquarter and udder. Hygienic practice at the time of milking and post milking handling of milk is important. Freshly drawn milk should be immediately cooled to 5°C within 4 hours. Housing of dairy animals should be designed to provide clean, dry, well ventilation, sufficient light and comfort environment.


