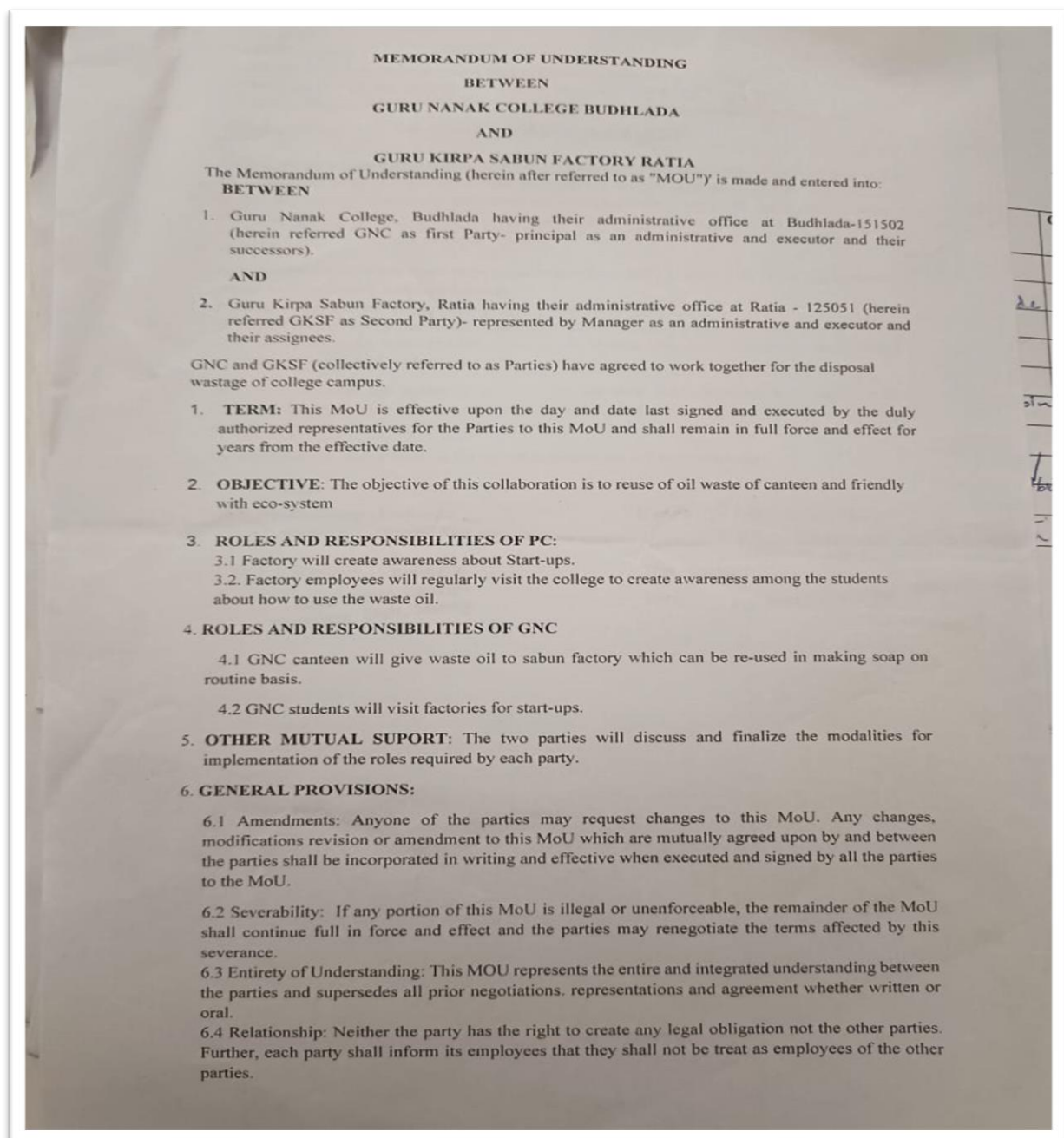

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Between: Guru Nanak College, Budhlada, and Pingalwara

6. Documentation:

- Both parties agree to maintain records of each food delivery, including the type and quantity of food items, dates of delivery, and any other relevant information.
