





Here are 12 basic rules all employees who handle or work around hazardous materials should know and follow

- 1. Follow all established procedures and perform job duties as you have been trained.
- 2. Be cautious and plan ahead. Think about what could go wrong and pay close attention to what you are doing while working with or around hazardous materials.
- 3. Always use required PPE; inspect it carefully before each use to make sure it's safe to use. Replace worn PPE; it won't provide adequate protection.
- 4. Make sure all containers are properly labeled and that materials are contained in an appropriate container. Don't use any chemical not contained or labeled properly. Report damaged containers or illegible labels to your supervisor immediately.
- 5. Read labels and the Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) before using any material to make sure you understand hazards and precautions.

Particulate matter: Solid and liquid particles that are suspended in the air, such as dust, pollen, soot, and smoke.



This process begins with an introduction to major government funding agencies, such as the National Institutes of Health (NIH), National Science Foundation (NSF), and Department of Energy (DOE). Each agency has its own focus areas, priorities, and funding mechanisms, making it essential for researchers to familiarize themselves with the specific requirements and expectations of their target agencies. Identifying suitable grant opportunities is the next critical step, which involves carefully reviewing funding announcements, program descriptions, and eligibility criteria to ensure alignment between the researcher's project and the agency's goals. This process often requires extensive research and consultation with colleagues, mentors, and program officers to identify the most appropriate funding opportunities. Once a suitable grant opportunity is identified, understanding the proposal guidelines and evaluation criteria becomes paramount. This involves clearly articulating the research questions, hypotheses, and specific aims of the project. The objectives should be well-defined, measurable, and achievable within the proposed timeframe. The methodology section should provide a detailed description of

Developing realistic project timelines and milestones is essential for demonstrating the feasibility of the proposed research. This involves breaking down the project into manageable tasks, estimating the time required for each component, and identifying key milestones and deliverables. A well-structured timeline not only helps in project planning but also demonstrates to reviewers that the researcher has carefully considered the logistics and practicality of the proposed work. It is important to account for potential delays or setbacks and to include contingency plans in the timeline. Creating accurate and justifiable budgets is a critical aspect of the grant application process. This involves carefully estimating the costs associated with personnel, equipment, supplies, travel, and other project-related expenses. Each budget item should be clearly justified and linked to specific project activities. Researchers must adhere to agency-specific budget guidelines and restrictions, such as salary caps or limitations on certain types of expenses.
